But what about the networking part of conferences?

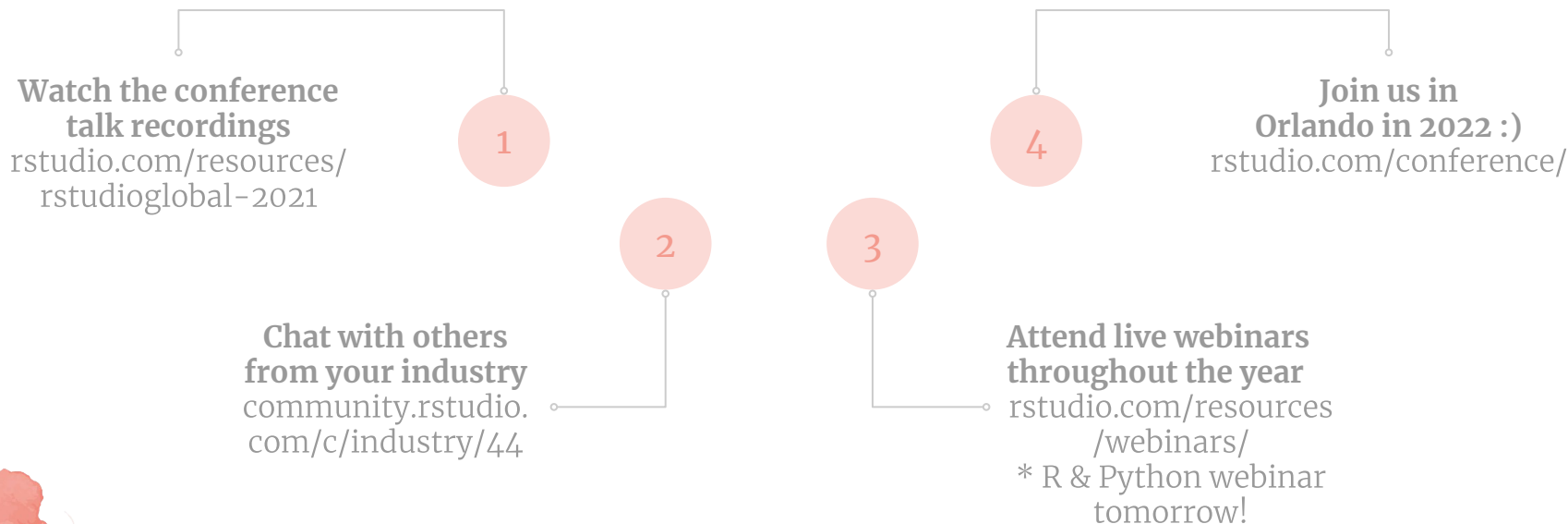
No that was not the same, but we tried to recreate what we could!
